FREE EYE CAMP AT SEHWAN SHARIF

January 15 18, 2009



Background:

Sehwan Sharif is located in Jamshoro District of Sindh Pakistan at the right bank of river Indus. Sehwan Sharif is famous in Pakistan and world level for Sufism due to the great saint Hazrat Qalandar Lal Shahbaz. The Manchar Lake the biggest lake of Asia is on a little distance from Sehwan Sharif.

Poverty and lack of health facilities, a large number of populations are suffering from different health problems including Eye diseases, particularly the cataract affected people, as there is no qualified ophthalmologist, posted in local Government hospitals.

The Board of directors of Fakhr-e-Imdad Foundation, in its meetings had decided to organize 3 Eye camps during current season, to provide free treatment and operation facilities to the poor people living in the far areas of rural Sindh, where people are living without such facilities.

After successful achievements of humanitarian services by organizing eye camps at Nagar Parker district Tharparkar and Digri district Mirpurkhas, the 3rd Eye camp of the foundation was organized in collaboration with society for the prevention and cure of blindness Karachi at Sehwan Sharif from 15th to 18th January, 2009.
